

Cisco Meraki

1. Definitions

In this section:

- (a) **Cisco Systems** means Cisco Systems, Inc.;
- (b) **Hardware** means the Meraki hardware products purchased under this Proposal, or otherwise running on the Customer's Network;
- (c) **Meraki** means Cisco Systems and its affiliates;
- (d) **Meraki Agreement** means the Cisco Enterprise Agreement 3.0 Program Terms – End Users and the Cisco General Terms agreed between Meraki and Cenitex;
- (e) **Meraki Documentation** means the technical specifications and use materials officially published by Meraki specifying the functionalities and capabilities of the Meraki products, as updated from time to time. The Meraki Documentation is set out at [Home - Cisco Meraki Documentation](#);
- (f) **Meraki Licensing Documentation** means the Meraki documentation on licensing models, as set out at [Meraki Licensing - Cisco Meraki Documentation](#) and as updated from time to time;
- (g) **Network** means the Customer's local area network, created in whole or in part by use of the Meraki products;
- (h) **Support Services** means the customer support services described at <http://meraki.cisco.com/support>; and
- (i) **User** means anyone who obtains access to the Customer's Network.

2. Use of the Products

- (a) The Customer must use a Meraki product in accordance with the Documentation. The Customer acknowledges that Cisco offers various licensing models for each Meraki product, and each model is subject to unique entitlements, restrictions, and enforcement behaviour described in the Meraki Licensing Documentation.
- (b) The Customer agrees to only use the Hardware in accordance with the specifications available on Meraki's Documentation.
